- **Meet the band:** Charlie Fick, lead and rhythm guitar/vocals/manager; Tony Karras, lead vocals/harp; Bill Rosser, lead vocals/rhythm guitar; Jeff Angstadt, bass; Bryan Hall, lead and rhythm guitar/pedal steel/vocals; Drew Egbert, drums.

**Year formed:** 2005

**What's in the name:** Steelhorse was named based on most of the people we play for and the main hobby of most band members. Steelhorse plays mainly for bikers, and we all know a true biker doesn't feel alive without the wind blowing through his hair or the rumble of the pipes coming from his "steelhorse."

**How we got started:** Most of us played in the same bands years ago and Charlie felt the need for a true Southern rock tribute band to satisfy the needs of the biker community, which includes ourselves.

**Genre:** Hard-core Southern rock "music for bikers and everyone else."

**Influences:** Steelhorse is influenced by playing off of each others' excellent capabilities to reproduce the true Southern rock experience.

**What's new:** In the short time that Steelhorse has been together, we have opened up for The Outlaws and Pure Prairie League in West Virginia. Also we have shared the stage with Jimmie Van Zant and are currently working on performing in Texas next year.

**Set list highlights:** While not catering to the standard variety dance music crowd, Steelhorse excels in the Southern rock format such as "Green Grass and High Tides" by the Outlaws and "Wishing Well" and "Highway Song" by Blackfoot. Molly Hatchet and Lynyrd Skynyrd also make up a good part of our set list. The band features dual lead guitars and four-part harmonies. Bring a chair, because you'll get tired of standing for those 15 minute guitar solos.
